

bKash to disburse fund among 10,000 poor under USAID programme

CARE Bangladesh, an international NGO will distribute cash digitally to the beneficiaries under SHOUHARDO-III programme via through bKash channel. The organization has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with bKash Limited in this connection last month.

The new partnership between CARE Bangladesh and bKash will help around 10,000 households, especially those who lack access to a traditional bank account, to receive the next round of cash inputs. Recipients can cash out the aid money at nearest bKash agent locations.
